Meningitis can be very serious if not treated quickly. Know the signs and symptoms of meningitis and septicaemia:

Fever and/or vomiting



Severe headache



Pale or mottled skin, or rash



Breathing fast, breathless



Limb, joint, muscle pain, stiff neck



Cold hands and feet, shivering



Dislike of bright lights, seizures (fits)



Very sleepy, difficult to wake, vacant, confused or delirious
