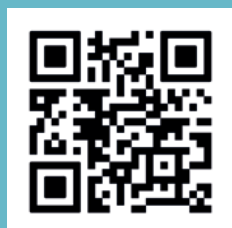
# There were some sources of **information that made a small proportion of parents worry**

# 85%

of parents had found information  
that they trusted and made them  
feel confident about vaccines

Only 15% of parents reported  
they had come across  
information that made them  
feel worried about vaccines.

This information that made parents  
worry most often came from:

- 56% friends, other parents
- 46% social media: Facebook
- 24% family members
- 24% internet: Netmums or Mumsnet
- 23% TV, magazines or radio
