Attitudes to the
childhood vaccination
programme in parents

Most parents were **satisfied with their most recent vaccine visit**

85%

were satisfied with
COVID-19 safety measures
at the practice

84%

found it easy to get a
convenient appointment

82%

were satisfied with the
information provided at
the visit

81%

were satisfied with waiting
room facilities

63%

were satisfied with
information provided
before the visit

Of the 688 parents who were not satisfied
with their latest visit:

- 32% felt they were not given enough
information or explanation
- 27% were concerned about pain, distress
or side effects caused by the vaccine
- 20% felt the procedures were too rushed
- 12% said it was the behaviour or attitude
of the health professional
