# Parents showed a **strong preference to have children vaccinated at their general practice**

Parents were asked to rate different options for where their baby or child could be vaccinated.

**84%**

of parents said they would definitely use their GP practice

**26%**

of parents said they would definitely use a pharmacist

**23%**

of parents said they would definitely use an other community venue (children's centre, community centre etc)

**14%**

of parents said they would definitely use mass vaccination centres (similar to COVID-19 vaccine centres)
